In this vast and

remote region of northern Kenya most people are nomadic, there is tribal rivalry, Islam is spreading, and several years of drought mean food is short. There are few churches and very limited resources, but the church is growing and new churches are being planted. There is a vibrant youth ministry, with training and Bible camps to equip young people to stand firm in their faith in Christ and be involved in evangelistic missions across the diocese. Pray that through this ministry, young people will be equipped to live boldly for Christ in a difficult environment.
